Written in the Stars: Cost Share Explanation & Example

Humanities Kansas 9/12/24

Cost share reflects all <u>local contributions</u> to a project that ensures its success at the community level. Humanities Kansas must report cost share to the National Endowment for the Humanities to demonstrate local-level interest and support of humanities programming.

As you consider cost share, remember:

- Everything used or done in support of the *Written in the Stars* project has a value.
- The following is an example of cost share that might apply. When submitting your final report, use your numbers.
- Below are some possible categories for cost share:
 - Project Staff
 - o Promotions and Publicity. Pro Tip: Even free advertising has a cost share value!
 - o Supplies
 - Equipment and Facilities. Consider how much it would cost to rent your space and equipment, such as chairs or a PA system.
 - o Printing and Program Materials.
 - o Other Expenses

EXAMPLE

The XYZ Museum received 20 copies of *Written in the Stars*. Printing the books cost HK \$4 per book (\$100 for 25 books), plus \$8 to ship. Below is an example of XYZ Museum's cost share. You can do this!
