

Room Set-Up

An actual stage is not needed to conduct an event. However, a “stage area” where Readers sit or stand in a semicircle facing the audience is suggested.

Readers will need adequate lighting to read their script and at least one microphone (positioned at the center of the stage) so Readers can walk to the microphone to read their parts. Readers should stand to read but then be seated.

The Audience should be seated so that Readers can be seen and clearly heard. A copy of the script and “take home” citation pages should be provided to each audience member.

X = indicates Humanities Facilitator, Narrator, and five Script Readers positioned in the stage area.
